



WiFi Policy

The Moline Public Library offers wireless network "WiFi" access to the Library's Internet service for properly equipped laptops. Use of the Internet in the Library constitutes acceptance of the Library's Internet Use Policy. Please read the policy before accessing the network or see a librarian for a written copy of the full policy.

In order to use the wireless network, the users will need to bring their 802.11a or 802.11g enabled device.

The Library's wireless network is not secure and is an open network. The Library cannot guarantee the safety of traffic across its wireless network. The Library assumes no responsibility for the configurations, security or files on laptops resulting from connection to the Library's network. Information sent to or from a laptop can be captured by anyone else with a wireless device and appropriate software, within the range of the access point.

The Library is not able to provide technical assistance, and there is no guarantee that patrons will be able to make a wireless connection. If assistance is needed, contact the manufacturer of the laptop or software. The Library is not responsible for any changes made to computer's settings.

The Library does not support printing through the wireless network.
